Applications are invited for the position of Director of Education of Regina Catholic Schools.

The Regina Catholic Board of Education is seeking a dynamic individual to lead the system in fulfilling the vision of the school division: *To provide a quality Catholic education that is faith-based, student-centered, and results oriented.*

The successful candidate will be a highly skilled and experienced educational leader who guides and supports the Board's governance responsibilities, while fostering collegiality and supporting continuous learning across the division.

The Director of Education must live the Catholic faith and be committed to building relationships and meaningful engagement with staff, students, education partners, and external stakeholders. Compassion and warmth combined with strong leadership skills are key attributes for success in the role.

Regina Catholic Schools (RCS) serves the educational needs of approximately 14,000 PreK-12 students, over 1,600 staff, including teachers, education support professionals and CUPE employees, in the city of Regina.

Regina Catholic Schools operate 32 schools, including five French Immersion elementary schools and one intensive supports school and four high schools, including three French Immersion schools.

Embodying the school division's values of accountability, collaboration, honesty, integrity, respect and wellness, the successful candidate will:

- report directly to the Board of Education, providing executive and operational leadership;
- lead the board and division staff in achieving the strategic priorities (vision, mission and goals) that the board has established;
- have sound knowledge of and commitment to pre-K to 12 Catholic education, embodying the school division's core commitments to students and families;
- demonstrate commitment to inclusion based on sound understanding and experience in supporting diverse learners and their success;
- demonstrate an open, approachable, and respectful leadership style with superior communication skills;
- model collaborative relationship development with the trustees, staff, students, and the community;
- take intentional steps toward reconciliation with Indigenous peoples in the communities served by Regina Catholic Schools;
- interface with multiple stakeholders, including government, school community councils, pre-K to 12 educational partners and related agencies.

Applications are invited from candidates who:

- meet the criteria for membership in the League of Educational Administrators, Directors and Superintendents (LEADS), including Professional A certification as a teacher, in Saskatchewan;
- possess a Master's degree, preferably in education, with a minimum of 15 years of relevant experience including 5 years of teaching experience;
- have demonstrated exemplary, successful leadership in a large or complex educational organization, with a minimum of 5 years' experience in a supervisory role at the administrative level.

Duties will commence by mutual agreement with the candidate/Board of Education, but no later than August 1, 2025.
